Building Bridges

We teamed up with the incredible Theatre Témoin, supported by the Mayor of London's Culture Seeds, to run this 16-week project that combined storytelling, puppetry and outdoor theatre.

We explored themes of 'home and 'journey' through drama, dance and song. This project was as much about the process as the final performance.

12 women attended the workshops and performed at Brighton Festival and Greenwich Family Arts Festival to over 300 audience members.

"Last year in May, we got an award from the Mayor of London, the Cultural Seeds Award. It was a very amazing thing because for you to get an award from the Mayor and going there, being called and going on the stage to get this award, a progress in one's life and not realising you can do such things."






We are immensely proud to have received the Culture Seeds award for Community Creator in May 2019 by the Mayor of London Sadiq Khan for our Building Bridges project.

My Creative Skills




Creating Ground has been running My Creative Skills workshops since September 2016 and thanks to Near Neighbours and University of Greenwich we have been able to continue.

These participant-led workshops unite women from migrant backgrounds to develop their leadership skills and share their creative strengths and unique ideas.

We've worked with up to 17 women in these sessions which allow participants to focus their energy into various artistic pursuits, and have created a strong community in the process.

Women and Leadership



Creating Ground partnered with Citizens UK, supported by Near Neighbours & Church Urban Fund, on a programme to strengthen leadership and inspire community action.

The 11 participants explored issues that are affecting many more people and communities like ours, particularly around housing. Every meeting culminated in agreeing on next actions for change with three powerful phrases at the centre - 'nurture love', 'speak the truth', and 'seek justice and freedom'.

We continue into 2020 to create positive change in ourselves and our communities.

"I was born into a very religious family who taught me the way of the lord. My parents also instilled in me family and cultural values of generosity, kindness and sense of duty. They also made sure that I had good education that brought me wealth of knowledge and learning. Creating Ground has been inspirational. It has provided avenue to express myself and latent abilities. Teaching Through Drama is a 5-day training course for teachers from across Europe. It looks at how education professionals can use drama as a tool to engage, motivate and support students. Creating Ground has been running the course since May 2016.

This year we have welcomed participants from Spain, France, Italy, Germany, Finland and Greece . We were able to offer 3 free spaces to Creating Ground participants and 2 free spaces for volunteers from our partner organisations.

Diversity, Cultural Awareness and Inclusion is a 5-day professional development course. We welcome participants from all over the world who want to improve how they work cross-culturally, to explore diversity, and to develop inclusive practices. Creating Ground has been running the course since May 2018.

This year we have had participants from Germany, Spain, Slovenia, Italy, Sweden, Poland and Greece. We were also able to offer 5 free spaces to Creating Ground participants.

Impact

Over the past year our small organisation has run 9 different projects in community education and arts across cultures, reaching over 210 participants.

Creating Ground's collaborative approach to all its work allows participants to gain confidence and capacity in a safe and encouraging environment.

Participants have reported a greater sense of belonging and confidence, as well as learning new skills.

100% of Teaching Through Drama course participants said they would recommend the course to other people.





Yewande's Experience


Words From Our Exhibition
